The facility remained fully operational while servicing 4,000 international passengers daily throughout the construction process. Facility upgrades include 24 reconfigured U.S. CBP booths, overhaul and upgrade of baggage claim area, addition of more Transportation Security Administration (TSA) baggage screening machines, build out of new TSA Screening Area and the expansion of the TSA passenger screening area. Other enhancements include streamlining the passenger flow, new floors, passenger information center, ceilings, wall finishes, light fixtures, artwork and additional restrooms.
